PINK PAISLEE SUPPLIES

- (2) AMBER ROAD Postcards Paper
- (1) AMBER ROAD Autumn Blossom Paper
- (1) AMBER ROAD Bonfire Paper
- (1) AMBER ROAD Punchout Tags

OTHER SUPPLIES

- 1. (2) 12" pieces of black gingham ribbon
- 2. (2) 6" pieces of black gingham ribbon
- 3. (1) 22" piece of twine for garland
- 4. (3) coordinating buttons
- 5. (6) 7mm bling rhinestones
- 6. 2 small photos
- 7. 2 sheets of 12" x 12" chipboard for pennant backer.

TOOLS

- Adhesive
- Pop Dots
- Scissors
- Paper Trimmer
- Hole Punch
- Ink (optional)

DIE CUT SHAPES

- ACCUCUT DIE #P1314
- ACCUCUT DIE #ZL1212S

project instructions

AMBER ROAD FAMILY GARLAND

STEP 1: Using the Accucut Die #P1314 die cut 3 pennant shapes out of the chipboard and the Postcards paper. Cut 2 pennant shapes out of the Autumn Blossom Paper and 1 pennant shape out of the Bonfire paper.

STEP 2: The patchwork effect that is created from the frontside of the postcards paper will be the base for your garland. Adhere this to the chipboard and then trim all 3 pieces to 5" measuring from the bottom of the pennant and cutting straight across at 5" (we did this to make our pennants smaller)

STEP 3: Trim the Bonfire paper, and the Autumn Blossom paper to 4" measuring from the bottom of the pennant tip and cutting straight across at 4"

STEP 4: Adhere the smaller pennant pieces on top of the larger pennant pieces (lining them up at the top) using Pop Dots to create a dimensional paper layer.

STEP 5: Locate the family memories die cut tag from the Punchout sheet and adhere to the center pennant.

STEP 6: Adhere buttons to the tips of each pennant.

STEP 7: Adhere a small photo to the left and right pennants.

STEP 8: Using the Accucut Die ZL1212S cut out 2 leaves (using the red distressed backside of the postcard paper scraps) and punch a hole at each stem -adhere bling to each leaf tip and set aside

STEP 9: Punch holes in the top corners of each pennant, thread onto the twine and tie the black gingham ribbon onto each end in a bow. Use the 6" strips of ribbon to tie the leaves onto the twine in between each pennant.
