project instructions

TWILIGHT CARD

STEP 1: Trim Nightfall patterned paper to 8" x 12" - be sure not to cut through the tree graphic on the front side. We will be using that later.

STEP 2: Take your 8" x 12" sheet and trim it down to 8" x 8" - then fold it in half to create a 4" x 8" vertical card. Fold it so the white pattern is on the inside and the black polka dot is on the outside of the card.

STEP 3: Trim the remaining paper (the scrap with the tree graphic) to 3.75" x 7.75" and distress the edges with your scissors. Adhere to the front of the card. ** Only add adhesive to the top of the paper for now.**

STEP 4: Slide the twine around the bottom half of the tree paper and tie in a bow on the front of the card. Now go ahead and adhere the bottom of the tree paper down so the twine doesn't slip out of the bottom.

STEP 5: Punch a circle out of the Horizon paper (green center) and then pierce a hole in the center. Add brad to center of punched circle and then adhere to top right hand corner of card for an accent.

STEP 6: Using the Accucut Poison Symbol Die cut #P1485S die cut a skull and crossbone accent out of chipboard and then die cut a skull and crossbone out of the Dusk paper (orange backside.) Adhere the paper to the chipboard matching chipboard piece and adhere them to the front of the card.

STEP 7: Add the green ric rac to the bottom of the card using glue dots.

STEP 8: Feel free to add bling rhinestone eyes to the poison symbol if you want!
