Altered Wooden Hook

OUR PRODUCTS

- Ambrose Alphabet (Bayberry)

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Paper Mache Hook
- Pearl Accents
- Metal Butterfly
- Rhinestones
- Sanding Block



TO CREATE THE ALTERED WOODEN HOOK:

STEP ONE

Paint the entire surface and sides of the plaque white. You will need to use at least 2 coats. Once dry, randomly sand the edges.

STEP TWO

Start out by taking the blue paper (Flower Garden) and cut it 4 x 3 1/4 in. Attach it roughly 1 3/4 in. from the top. Sand the edges.

STEP THREE

Punch two small circles and one medium circle from the Flower Garden paper, sand the edges, and attach randomly to the blue paper.

STEP FOUR

Slightly overlapping the blue paper, use the Artisan tape to create a border above the blue paper. It will be about 3 1/4 in. long.

STEP FIVE

Next, use the clear strips (again 3 1/4" long) and attach it right above the Artisan tape.

STEP SIX

Trim the green paper (Picket Fence)

to 2 1/4" x 3 1/4" long. Use a punch or decorative scissors to create a scallop border on one end. Attach right below the blue paper and sand the edges.

STEP SEVEN

Cut another piece of the green paper (Picket Fence) and cut it to 3/4" by 3 1/4". Again use a punch or decorative scissor to cut the edge of the paper. Attach right on top of the first layer of green paper and sand the edges.

STEP EIGHT

Cut the Bayberry Cottage ribbon pleat (in green) 3 1/4" and adhere over the blue and green paper to hide the seams.

STEP NINE

Use the Bayberry Cottage bella brad to decorate the center of a matching flower. Attach to the right of the ribbon pleat (I also cut made a little leaf for the flower).

STEP TEN

Punch a butterfly, bend the wings slightly, and attach to the flower or leaf.

STEP ELEVEN

Place a line of pearls along the ribbon pleat, and to the center of the butterfly.
